**Graduation Rates**

The graduation rate of first-time, full-time students who started between the timeframe of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014 and completed their program of study within 150% of the normal projected timeframe is 52%. **Retention Rates**

The retention rate cohort consists of first-time, full-time degree seeking students who began their program of study in Fall 2018 (August 1, 2018 – October 31, 2018) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the end of Fall 2019. The retention rates for first-time, full-time students for the Fall 2018 cohort by campus are provided in the table below. The institutional and campus retention rates were calculated using the IPEDS formula. If a Campus does not appear in the list below then there were no first-time, full-time entering students in Fall 2018.
